page 78- In 1813 Mark Blanchard and Eber Hotchkiss erected the first sawmill at Centerville, and a Mr. Warren built the first gristmill in Rushford.

page 790- In 1813 was built by a Mr. Warren the first gristmill. This mill stood on land now owned by John B. Walker. - - - - - The first miller was drowned in 1815 while repairing the dam. Mr. Warren also built the first sawmill.

page 799-Mr. William Gordon's first wife was the first person that died in town. A young man by the name of Hubbard was the second, and Mr. Warren, who was drowned, was the third. In 1816 the only grave near the center of the town was Mr. Warren's. (Rushford)

Beers' History of Allegany County, New York 1879

page 328- THE TOWN OF RUSHFORD - - - - - Woodworth was a native of Coventry, Conn. and he and White came from that state on foot. The former located on lot number 28. The Indians had underbrushed the woods about the site of his residence on Caneadea Creek and used the place as a camping ground. A man named Warren had located in Rushford previous to this date.

page 329- A grist mill, which has been described by Turner in "History of the Holland Purchase" was erected by the early settler Warren. already mentioned, in 1813. The early miller was drowned two years later while engaged in making repairs on his mill-dam.

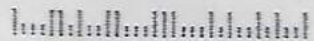
