EDWARD J. FLEMING

ANGELICA — Edward J. Fleming, 68, of 51 Mechanic St. died Wednesday (Oct. 18, 1989) in Jones Memorial Hospital, Wellsville, after a long illness.

On the reverse are arranged, alphabetically, the names of Angelica men who served in the Civil War. These names are taken from Beers Allegany County History, published in 1879, fourteen years after the end of the war. For those names found in the cemetery records, and the physical inventory taken in June 1981, the cemetery numbers for section, block, lot and grave have been filled in. Thus it is certain that 36 of the 102 Angelica men who went to war 1861-1865 are now in 'Til the Day Dawn Cemetery, Angelica. It ought not to be assumed that the remaining 66 are buried elsewhere. Many are doubtless among the 496 unmarked graves in the cemetery.

The 42 veterans on the other list and now known to be in the cemetery may have been living in towns other than Angelica when called up, settling in Angelica after the war.

Barring some erroneous placement of the flag holders, we are sure that there at least 78 Civil War Veterans in 'Til the Day Dawn Cemetery, Angelica.

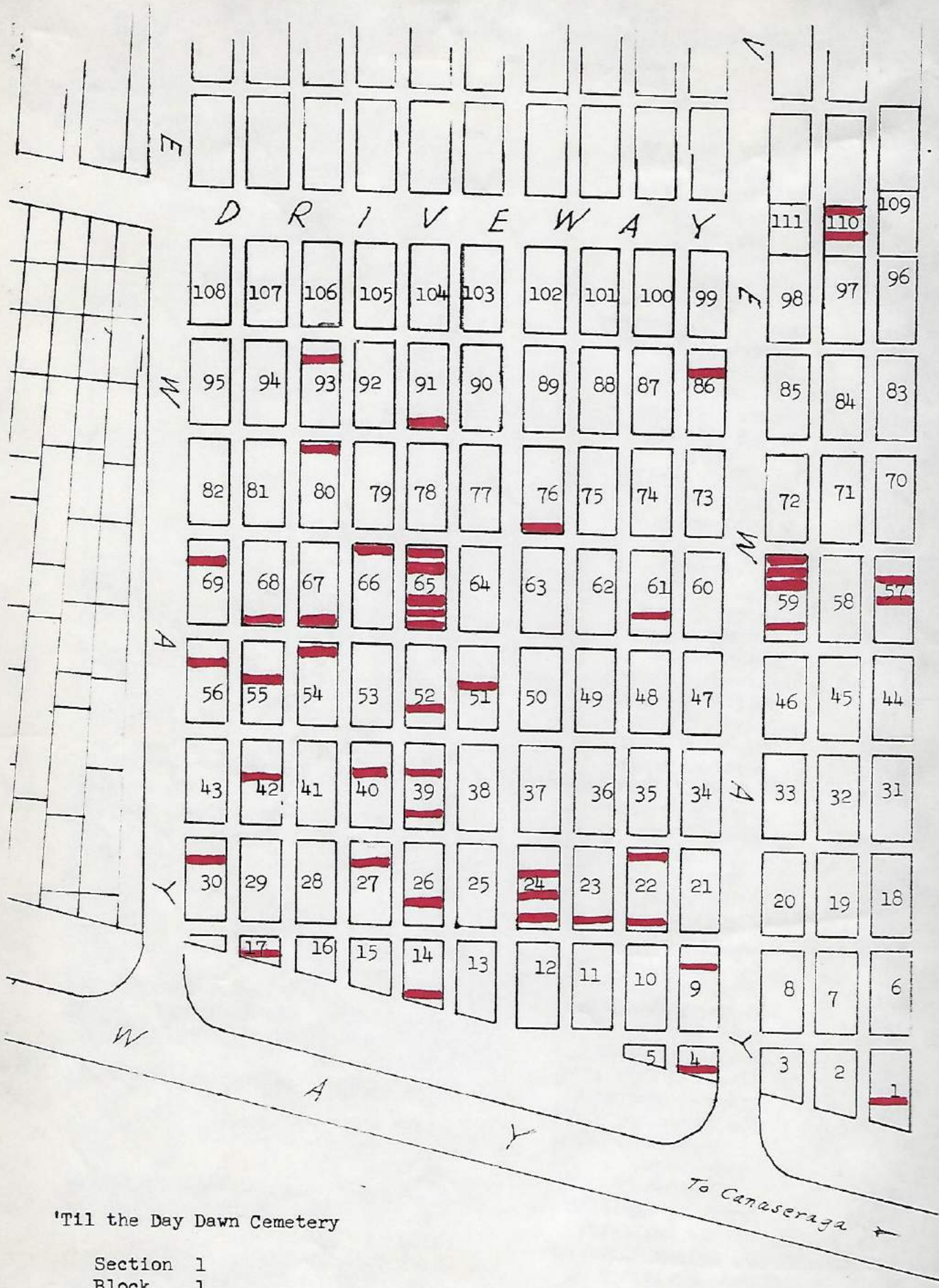

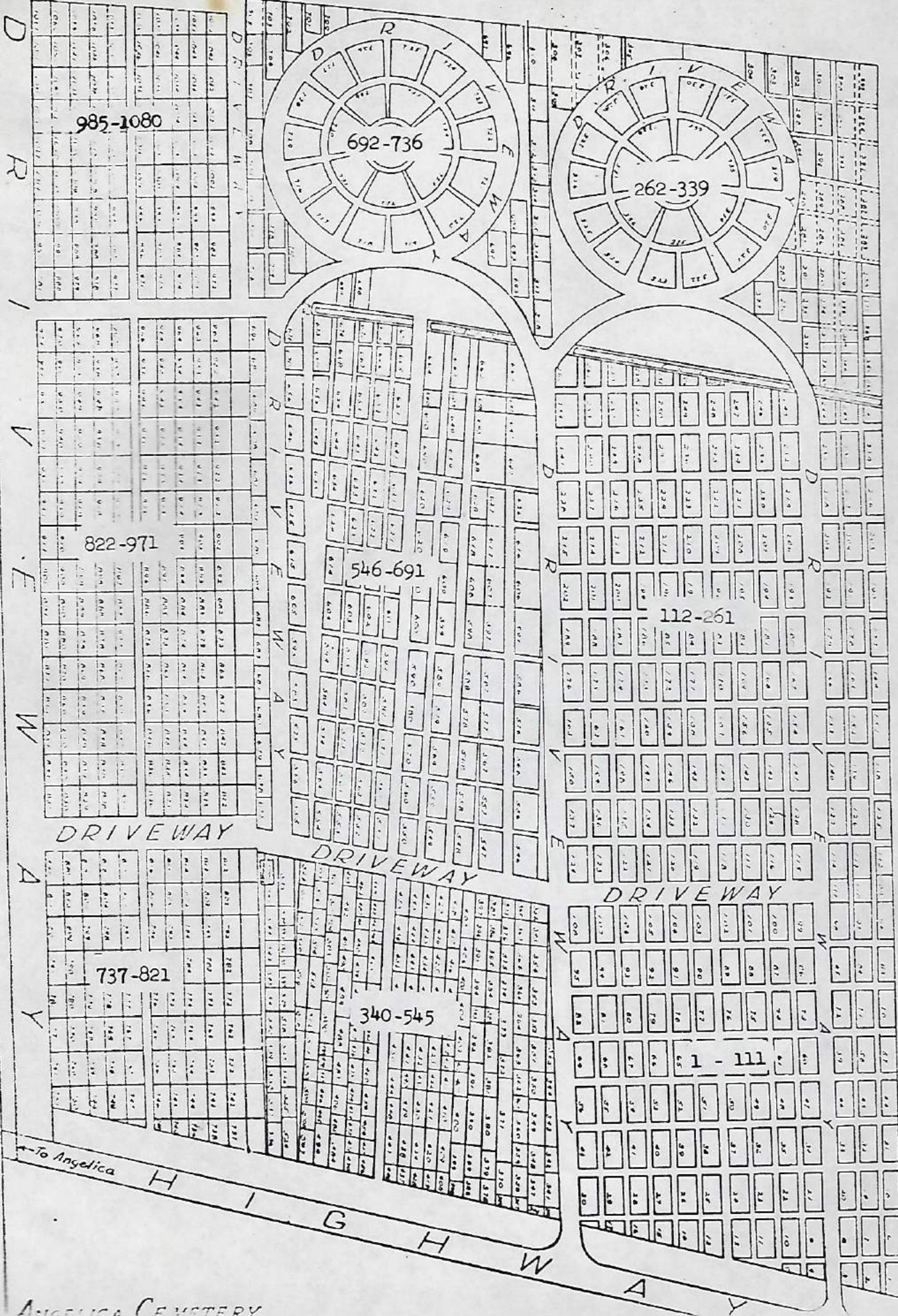
